The Union and Finning have concluded 3 days of bargaining July 28-30.

Your Bargaining Committee has continued to try and advance the benefit improvements and increased job security language that you requested as your priorities. We have not been successful in getting the company to agree to any significant improvements.

The company continues to press for their continuous shift language. There has been NO agreement as what the terms of a continuous shift may look like. The union is promoting the terms of any site-specific shift LoU that would be acceptable to the employees required to work the shift.

Your bargaining committee is working hard to get the improvements that your surveys advised were important to you.

As yet we have not confirmed any more dates with the company.

As a reminder to everyone that the collective agreement remains in full effect during the bargaining process.
